If you request FastPay Ltd Re Sean Devereux Children's Fund to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by FastPay Ltd Re Sean Devereux Children's Fund or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society. **If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when FastPay Ltd Re Sean Devereux Children's Fund asks you to.**
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your Bank or Building Society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

The gift of education is the best possible gift you can give a child; Sean gave it in his role as a teacher, firstly here in the UK and then in Liberia, and the Sean Devereux Children's Fund is maintaining that legacy through our Sponsorship Programme.

Currently there are over 300 children being educated in Liberia, directly as a result of the Sean Devereux Sponsorship Programme.

This is all being achieved in a country which is one of the poorest on the planet: in recent history, Liberia has been ravaged by civil war; suffered over 4000 deaths during the Ebola crisis and is a place in which, according to UNICEF, up to two thirds of primary children do not attend school.

Education represents hope and the Sean Devereux Sponsorship Programme is the gift of hope for the deserving children of Liberia.
